SETTLEMENT CLAIM FORM

This is the claim form for the Quebec class members who own or use one of the effected locks.

A. EXPLANATION OF AVAILABLE BENEFITS TO CLASS MEMBERS

1. The Defendants have developed a do-it-yourself installation (“DIY”) Upgrade Kit which, when installed into the lock’s chassis, will deter magnetic manipulation. All class members are entitled to receive one DIY Upgrade Kit for each corresponding effected lock in their possession. Defendants will provide the DIY Upgrade Kit to such Class Members without charge and postage-paid. The cost of the DIY Upgrade Kits and the postage for those kits will not be deducted from the Maximum Installation and Shield Costs (as defined below).

2. The Defendants have also set aside up to \$80,000 to cover the Shield Costs and Installation Claims made by End-User Class Members *who purchased their effected locks after January 1, 2001* (“Maximum Installation and Shield Costs”), as described below.

a) Class members who purchased their effected locks ***after January 1, 2001*** shall have the following alternative to the right (as described above in paragraph 1) to receive one DIY Upgrade Kit for each lock:

i. The Defendants have developed a do-it-yourself installation (“DIY”) Shield for Simplex 1000, L1000, 6000, 7000 and 8100 series locks. Instead of receiving a DIY Upgrade Kit, Class Members who, ***after January 1, 2001***, purchased a model/series of these locks for which Defendants make a DIY Shield may elect to receive one DIY Shield for each effected lock. Class members who receive a DIY Shield shall not be eligible for the installation benefit as described in the next paragraph. Defendants’ costs for the shields shall be deducted from the Maximum Installation and Shield Costs at the flat rate of \$10 per shield; or

ii. Class members who purchased their effected lock after January 1, 2001 are eligible to have Respondents arrange for professional installation of a DIY Upgrade Kit. The Defendants’ costs of installation of the DIY Upgrade Kits shall be deducted from the Maximum Installation and Shield Costs.

a. If the total costs of installation do not exceed the Maximum Installation and Shield Costs, then the installation will be free for the eligible class claimant.
